## MINUTES & GENERAL ACCOUNT TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS October 28, 2016 – SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Transylvania County met in special session on Friday, October 28, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. in the Arthur C.
